How to Participate:

- Register and submit a collaboration profile online at www.futurematch.cebit.de
- Registration must be received by **Wednesday February 10, 2010**, in order to organize the requested meetings.
- Once your firm is registered, you can select potential partners for meetings during CeBIT

View and Select partners to meet with:

- Using the on-line search functions at www.futurematch.cebit.de, screen and select companies to meet with – your meeting request immediately notifies the other partner and they accept or decline the invitation to meet.
- All accepted meetings are automatically registered in your “Future Match” meeting schedule.

Who can participate:

- Anyone attending CeBIT including ICT industry businesses, government and/or educational representatives may participate.
